


### The Purpose

#### WHAT IS THE WSIC DASHBOARD??

A tableau based dashboard linking in primary, secondary and social care data to produce an **integrated care record** for patients .

The electronic record can then be reviewed by a range of health and social care providers and will provide them with a **joined-up care history** of each patient.







### How did the WSIC journey start?

- Started approximately 5 years ago
- NWL was chosen for the Integrated Care Pilot (ICP)
- To use integrated care data to understand the population, to find innovative was of working together to better support the needs of the population
- Years of work setting up Governance to allow information sharing between providers
  - NWL Information Governance Group established
  - Information Sharing Agreement (ISA) created
  - Data Controllers signing up to the ISA
- Dashboards were developed to support the work that developed into Whole Systems Integrated Care (WSIC)
- Clinical Advisory Group (CAG) set up to lead the direction of the development of the dashboards
